

Emergency School Closure Arrangements

The safety and wellbeing of our Pupils are always our top priority. In the event of severe weather or an unexpected incident, we will always take a careful and considered approach when deciding whether the school can safely remain open.

We will always aim to keep the school open wherever possible, as we know how important routine and consistency are for our Pupils. However, if it is not safe to do so, the Headteacher will make the decision to close the school, either fully or partially.

If the school does need to close, we will contact Parents/Carers directly by telephone. We may also share updates via email and on the school website. To help us keep in touch, please ensure that your contact details are always up to date.

If disruption happens overnight, we will aim to make a decision as early as possible, ideally by 7:30am, so families can plan accordingly.

In the event that severe weather or an incident develops during the school day, we will always try to remain open until the usual end of the day. If this is not possible, we will contact Parents/Carers and ask for children to be collected as soon as it is safe to do so.
