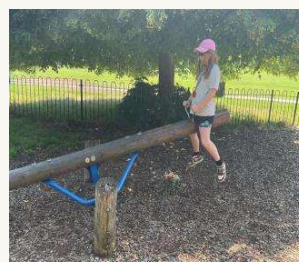
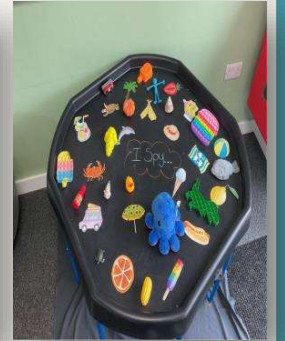

THERAPIES TEAM

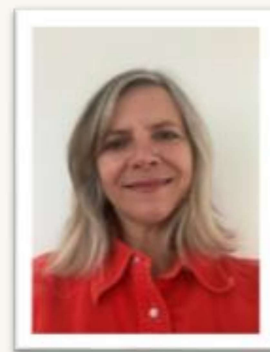

Sometimes these feelings can get 'trapped' inside. Art Therapy offers a gentle, fun and often a relaxing way, for children and young people to express themselves. It's not about being good at art. There is no right or wrong in how children creatively express themselves.

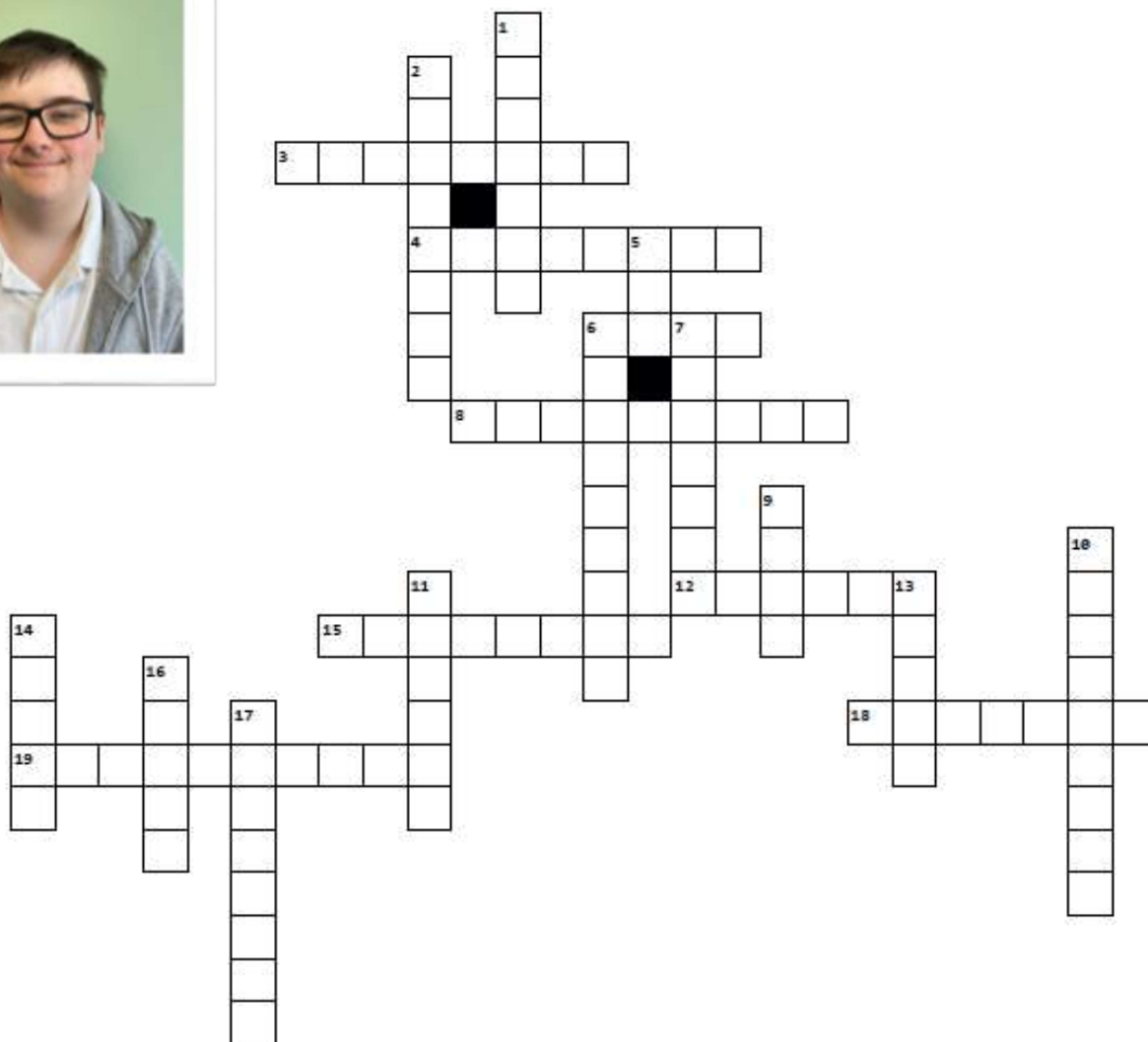
Through creative activities, and within a safe and supportive relationship with a trained Art Therapist, children can begin to explore their emotions and make sense of their experiences. This can support their emotional wellbeing, as well as their communication and self-understanding. Art Therapy can also help children to build confidence and resilience at their own pace, in a way that feels comfortable for them.
